Game Report / Misconduct Form Guidelines



1. The Game Report and Game Misconduct Report is one form used within NMCSL.
2. Each team playing a NMCSL match is required to present a completed Game/Misconduct Report (roster included) to the Center Referee prior to the game. It is recommended for Associations to make additional BLANK forms available at game fields in case the coach has misplaced the form, one may be filled out and presented to the Center Referee **PRIOR TO THE START OF THE MATCH**.
3. If **NO** cards (cautions or ejections) occur during the game, the center referee will complete the Game/Misconduct Report(s) and return go the appropriate teams.
4. If any of the following occur during the game - Caution or Ejection (any card or coach/player ejection):
 - a. The center referee will document the caution(s)/ejection(s) on the Report with necessary details (using the back of the form as needed).
 - b. The center referee will **NOT** return the Report to the team in question; the referee will inform the coach of the final score for reporting purposes.
 - c. The center referee will submit the Report to a place designated by the home association for the playing field. Each member association will determine a person/place to drop the form at the fields; this will be visible to the coaches.
5. Each Association in NMCSL has one A & D representative whose responsibility is to collect Game/Misconduct Reports in a timely manner.
6. Once the Reports have been collected, it is the responsibility of the A & D contact to enter the information from the Misconduct portion of the Report into the NMCSL database.
7. The A & D Chairman for the home Association where the game took place will retain the Game/Misconduct Report until such time as it may be needed for a hearing or collected at the end of the season by the A & D Chairman of NMCSL.

Additional Notes:

- Sit Out Verification forms are the responsibility of the Coach to be provided to the center referee **PRIOR** to the game in question. The player **MUST** be present for the entire game and the referee will sign and return the form to the coach at the conclusion of the game. It is the responsibility of the coach to return the signed form to the team's home association A&D chairperson.
- The home association A&D chairperson will submit the sit-out information in the NMCSL A&D system.
